

STUDY ABROAD STUDENT FINANCE INFORMATION

Students who study abroad at one of Cardozo's partner programs are required to register at Cardozo and pay full tuition and fees to Cardozo. All Cardozo financial aid, including scholarships and grants, remain intact for the semester abroad at the partner program. There may be additional host institution fees that students will be required to pay as well. Eligible students may apply for additional federal aid to cover living expenses and travel costs.

Students who study abroad independently through another ABA school or direct enrollment at a foreign law school will be required to take a Leave of Absence and will not be charged tuition or fees at Cardozo for the semester. In these cases, students will not be enrolled at Cardozo, will pay tuition and fees at the other institution directly, and will not be eligible to receive any Cardozo scholarships or grants. Eligible students will still have access to federal aid through Cardozo to cover costs of tuition charges, living expenses, and travel for such independent study abroad programs. To utilize federal aid while studying abroad, a consortium agreement between Cardozo (home school), the study abroad institution (visiting school), and the eligible student is required.
